5. **OTHER BUSINESS:**

- a. Equity in COR (i.e. OER) – Judson
- **IDEAA Presentation:** Reviewed slide 6 from IDEAA presentation, focusing on equity.
 - **OER Review:** Resources from Culturally Responsive Assessment Tool and OER files discussed.
 - **Key Discussion Points:**
 - OER text recommendation for each course by discipline expert.
 - Potential actions include: a. Motion to recommend OER in course outlines. b. Equity training for Curriculum Committee members. c. Discussion on recommendations.
 - **Training Needs:** Suggestion for OER resource training (Shagun/James as trainers).
 - **Equity Committee's Recommendations:** Guidance on expectations for OER inclusion.
 - **Motion Proposed:** Recommendation for OER text in COR, effective Fall 2026, not mandatory, but a suggestion.
 - **Designation of OER:** Exploring tutorials, videos, and articles as supplementary materials, and how discipline experts evaluate OER resources.
 - **Discussion Points:**
 - How much time should faculty spend finding OER? Is it equitable?
 - Good faith process with exceptions managed by Division Representatives.
 - A central repository for OER resources in community colleges.
 - Encouragement to attempt integrating OER and facilitate conversations.
- b. New Course Creation for Fall 2027 Messaging – Judson and Singh
- **CCN Impact:** 80 new courses expected in the pipeline for CCN, with significant workload for Curriculum Office (CO) and Articulation Officer (AO).
 - **Request for New Course Filing:** New courses should only be submitted if absolutely necessary due to capacity constraints. Aim is to avoid creating unnecessary delays.
 - CTE courses may be exceptions.
 - Messaging should be friendly and not create barriers for faculty, but there is a need to balance workload.
 - **Prioritization:** Focus on sunset courses (credit/noncredit) as part of the decision-making process.

- c. Course Sunset Policy Exceptions (Honors and Noncredit) – Singh
 - **APPROVED** – (M/S/C—Steiner/D’Agostino) – to exclude honors and noncredit courses from the sunset policy as long as the non-honors or credit course is not on the sunset list.
 - d. Reviewing AB1111 CCN (Common Course Numbering) Courses – Singh
 - With the upcoming review of 80 CCN courses, Singh emphasized the need for data-driven decisions on how many new courses can realistically be processed.
 - The team agreed to communicate the capacity limitations to colleagues, encouraging them to delay new course submissions unless absolutely necessary to avoid overloading the system.
 - e. Technical Review - Extend Meetings by 30 Minutes – Singh
 - Discussion on extending meetings by 30 minutes to accommodate reviewing 25 courses.
 - Mixed opinions:
 1. Some suggested being more efficient within the current meeting structure.
 2. Others proposed informal extensions based on team needs.
 3. Consideration of commitments beyond 4 PM for team members.
 - Agreed to commit to finishing reviews ahead of time and re-evaluate if informal extensions do not work.
 - f. FYI – Articulation Report – Steiner
 - Reported the UC approvals for fall 2025 and will be submitted for GE by December.
 - g. Public Comments
 - Ray and the committee congratulated D’Agostino on scoring seven touchdowns in the last game.
 - Singh announced he will be ordering coffee mugs for the committee members.
 - h. New Course Form Approval Process – Singh
 - **APPROVED** – (M/S/C—Ray/Judson) – The new course form approval process be reviewed by CAT to provide feedback to initiators. The dean and faculty will be invited to a CAT meeting for a Q & A. **AMENDED** – (M/S/C—Judson/Liu) – Amended the process to include programs.
