Title: Check-ins for Committee Updates so far

Description: To share how things are going, updates or concerns.

Presenters: Everyone

Time: 10 minutes

- Luiza: Equity and Diversity has been doing well, worried about people's mental health as students are already feeling sick/tired, how can we support students and ourselves?
- Afiza: ES is doing well, right on track with great plans
- Justin: Flea Market doing well, emailing around, markets in Bay Area are a lot cheaper than De Anza- projected earnings are lower than they should be, wants suggestions
 - Sarah Morales: Holding flea markets more often with bigger turnout
 - Justin: Possibly changing time to night flea market, wants to hold it every week, needs money but does not have budget
 - Sunnie: Is vendors are expensive, we can possibly partner with student companies and let them have a % of earnings
 - Justin: Problem is trust- how much they're making and needs to have police at every place where money is changing hands- costly
 - Getting a budget will help redecorate and make the flea market more appealing, hoping for about 200 vendors, holding market at night 4 times a week
- Finance: A lot of decrease from budget to allocate this year (about 300 000). Chairs should request money for next year's committees
- Sarah M: Elections is working on presentation to advertise DASG and recruit interns, underrepresented students to join
- Luiza: Catherine is planning an in person event for DASG including ICC and Mentors at De Anza, fundraiser, and get to know each other
- Erin: LAC has started looking at and changing bylaws, in the next meeting there will be the first look at changes
- Sunnie: Marketing- Art Guild will help with logo, wants to compensate them, introduction of Senate by the end of this week, chairs should fill out form Sunnie sent by friday,
- Helya: SSF needs interns, working on student concerns form, student resource fair (most likely will be in online flyer handout format), feedback taskforce, and other projects are getting worked on
- Sharron: Last year they sent general email to students looking for interns

- Sunnie: Sending emails to professors will be helpful for recruiting interns from classes

2. INFORMATION/DISCUSSION

- Luiza: certain clubs such as hip hop and DJ might be able to contribute
- Anahi: Maybe every few months we can have a multicultural event.
- Anahi: Please bring ideas for possible organizations for the next meeting
- Sarah: Planning halloween event and other events needs to be done far in advance, we also need to have resources/organizations to have student retention at these events to give students a motivation to attend
