An evocative vignette that introduces fully fledged characters through action and delivers an impactful journey by remaining focused on the central relationships. This story about the mending of a strained sisterhood finds its greatest strengths in fun dialogue, a controlled scope, and clever pacing—giving the audience insight into backstory through layered dialogue and subtext. The script is a breezy read, building to one climactic moment, planted early, and providing the reader with an unexpected yet satisfying ending.
