



DeAnza College Total Energy Consumption (MBtu)



10% decrease in energy use intensity (EUI) 2001 – 2019






De Anza College Carbon Use Intensity Trend (lbs CO2e/sf/yr)

DeAnza College Carbon Use Intensity (lbs CO2e/gsf)








