SEA 2022-2025 Overview

- Required by State; SEA 2022-2025 Plan submitted November 2022
- Five metrics; college sets local goals
- Select the student group experiencing disproportionate impact
- Narratives
 - Q: What outcomes will college target (annually) for this metric and population?
 - Q: What is the college's <u>current</u> process/policy/practice/culture that impedes equitable outcomes for this population?
 - Q: What equity-minded process/policy/practice/culture would <u>facilitate a shift</u> to equitable outcomes for this population?
 - Q: How do you plan to move from the current practice to a more ideal practice to achieve your stated goal?
 - Q: Which supports among the options listed can the Chancellor's Office provide to assist in reaching your ideal structure for this population and metric?



SEA 2022-2025 Metrics

Five metrics:

- 1. Successful enrollment in the first year (applied and enrolled in the same year)
- 2. Persisted first primary term to next primary term (fall-winter, winter-spring, or spring-next fall)
- Completed transfer-level English & Math in the first year
- 4. Attained CCCCO approved degree/certificate within 3 years (Vision for Success completion)
- 5. Transferred to four-year institution within 3 years

Baseline data year: most recent year for data is 2020-21

- Some metrics need two+ years to allow enough time for outcomes to transpire
 - Most recent persistence data available starting with 2019-20
 - Most recent degree/certificate attainment data available starting with 2018-19
 - Most recent transfer completion data available starting with 2016-17



Disaggregation Groups

- Data Disaggregation: State provided date to each college
 - Ethnicity
 - Gender
 - LGBTQ+
 - Low income
 - First-generation college

- Foster youth
- Students with disabilities
- Veteran
- Homelessness



DI Methodology

- Updated Methodology: PPG minus 1 (PPG-1)
 - Prior method: outcome rate of a subgroup versus outcome rate of ALL students

New method: outcome rate of a subgroup versus outcome rate of all OTHER students

Prioritizing DI Student Groups

- 1. Examined State-provided data
 - >> identified which students groups are DI for each metric
- 2. Of the DI student groups
 - >> cross referenced with Educational Master Plan 2022-2027 prioritized (7) student groups (i.e., Black, Filipinx, Latinx, Native American, Pacific Islander, Foster youth, and LGBTQ+)
 - >> rationale: aligning two strategic plans for continuity; maximize efforts and resources
- 3. Took DI student groups who are also EMP student groups
 - >> reviewed snapshot and trend data for student outcomes by metric
- 4. Recommended DI student groups






Metric 1: Successful Enrollment






Metric 2: Persistence






Metric 3: Transfer-Level English & Math






Metric 4: Degree/Certificate
