Subject: Career Technical Education (CTE) Enrollment Gains, Fall 2018 to Fall 2022

De Anza experienced a 15% enrollment decline campuswide over the past 5 fall terms, between fall 2018 and fall 2022, with the greatest decline from fall 2020 to fall 2021 as a result of the pandemic.

During this same period, enrollment in CTE courses grew from 7,704 to 3,040, a 28% increase, compared to non-CTE enrollment which saw a 30% decrease over the same period. Even though CTE enrollment experienced a decline in fall 2021, similar to the campus, its fall 2021 rate was still higher than its fall 2018.

The share of CTE enrollments grew from 16% in fall 2018 to 26% in fall 2022.

All divisions that offered CTE courses saw an increase in enrollments with Computer Science and Business (CB) division growing by 36%. The CB division nearly regained its pre-pandemic enrollment in fall 2022; the CB division also had the greatest CTE enrollment across all divisions. The Social Science (SS) grew by 31%, and has nearly regained its pre-pandemic enrollment levels for the fall 2022 compared to fall 2019. The Biological Health and Environmental Studies (BHES) division grew by 15%. They have yet to recover to pre-pandemic enrollment levels.




Figure 3. Fall Enrollment of Career Technical Education (CTE) by Division
