- The Measure G Task Force was asked to deliver update to Board of Trustees in July and final recommendations by October. Marco and Alyssa are members as well as Daniel Smith.
- Jennifer Mahato is leaving the college July 1, and will not be a part of the Measure G Task Force after June 9 (today).
- Foothill has been pressing the Board and others to use half of the money originally slated for the De Anza Events Center. The task force is working to stop this, but additional pushback from us and our allies is needed.
- Budget restrictions may limit us to a 2-story building.
- Designers were selected in part because of their experience building theaters. However, that is no longer the primary space need. They will need to be apprised of the specialized needs for areas they do not have experience with.
- Gallery displays will be needed in hallways.
- Plan below consolidates programs from not only A quad but other Creative Arts programs spread across 10 buildings.
